| Funding | Huib Attema confirmed that the Community Council Harbour Account now stands at £22,051.04. |
| Harbour Works | <p>The Chairman has been advised by Aberdeenshire Council that a Pay and Display parking machine may be available. The parking machine will require power and it may be possible to obtain this from the street lighting. The Chairman will look into this and other possibilities.</p> <p>Costings still have to be obtained for the signage. Lewis Cowie said he had received a quotation for the work on the Boatie Shore of £8,000 plus VAT. It was noted that this was twice as much as the original estimated cost. Also a funding bid to support this work from the Crown estate was unsuccessful. Further options for the work will be investigated.</p> <p>It was suggested that the collection box at the ramp to the beach be moved to beside the new bollard as this would be better seen by passers-by.</p> |
| Harbour Survey | <p>The group then moved from the Collieston Community Centre to the Harbour.</p> <p>Considerable damage to the pier from the winter storms was noted which will require further repairs to be considered. It is unlikely there will be funds available to support work this year. A plan of the car parking spaces which are to be marked out by Scottish Water was drawn up. It was noted that the hatches have not yet been repaired.</p> <p>Measurements were taken for an estimate to be submitted for harbour fittings.</p> <p>Repositioning of the collection box as earlier discussed in “Harbour Works” was then considered but it was felt that the existing position was probably the most effective.</p> |
